Ryan Marvel, pianist and composer will be performing **Friday, October 12 at 7:00 p.m.** in the sanctuary, the concert is free and open to the public.

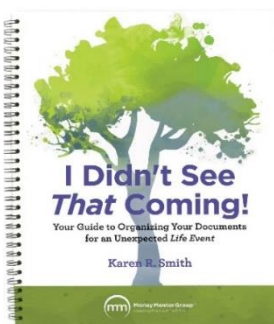
