The next step in a possible capital campaign

There will be a special information meeting on Thursday, January 10 at 7:00 p.m. in the Parlor, to present the findings of the recently completed feasibility study and recommendation of the organ funding task force. Members of the Church Council are invited as well others from the congregation. The task force has reviewed the report and prepared a one-page summary and three recommendations. They also put together a FAQ sheet in response to comments that were made during the feasibility study. No action would be taken at this information meeting.

The following week, on Thursday, January 17, we will have a special meeting of the Church Council called to act on the recommendations. It was unanimous among the task force members that it would be important to make a decision about a potential capital campaign as soon as possible without waiting until the next scheduled meeting of the Church Council at the end of January.
