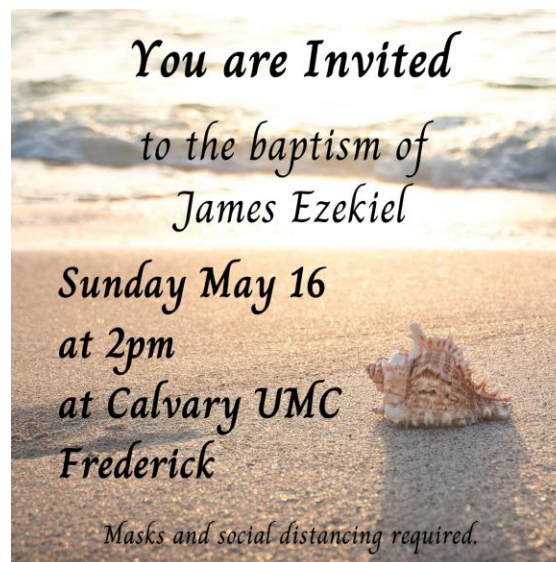
If you are someone who would like to help others in the church secure an appointment, please let us know so we can match you up with those who are having difficulties.
