Announcement

On Tuesday, May 24, a group will be heading to Mission Central in Mechanicsville, PA to provide an afternoon packing and preparing emergency kits to be shipped wherever there is a natural disaster or conflict. Mission Central is a Christian mission organization that works closely with United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR) has other organizations to offer other services and resources.

In 2020, Mission Central served over 3.3 million people with over \$10.9 million in donated resources including medical supplies and equipment, disaster relief, school supplies, food, and provided PPE for hospitals, first responders, and educators. Eighty percent of the resources were used domestically and 20% were sent overseas. Each year, Mission Central hosts between 6,000 and 8,000 volunteers in the campus. In the summer of 2021, a group of youth from Calvary United Methodist Church went as a team of volunteers as part of their mission week.

We hope to take group of 10 to 12 people to work in the Mission Central warehouse. We will leave Frederick at 11:00 AM and return by 4:30 PM. Arrangements can be made for transportation and lunch.


