
Upcoming in Worship

Beginning January 18, our winter worship series, **The People We Are Becoming**, invites our whole church family to reflect on who we are and who God is calling us to be. Rooted in the Wesleyan tradition and grounded in Christ's love, we will explore what it means to live into the United Methodist mission of making disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world.



Guided by the Holy Spirit, this season will invite us to grow as disciples who practice love, seek justice, offer mercy, and walk humbly with God. Together, we will look honestly at our past, celebrate the ways God is at work among us now, and imagine the future God is calling us to build here in Frederick.

Through worship, prayer, and reflection, we will renew our commitment to joyful service in our community and to lives of faith that are lived out in word and action. Each week, we will explore a different dimension of our shared calling, discovering how discipleship takes shape not only in what we believe, but in how we live, love, and serve together as the people God is forming us to be.
