Linton, Jr. Emergency Shelter, a year-round facility providing a safe place to sleep, hygiene services, and case management as individuals work toward stable housing. They also offer homelessness prevention assistance, such as rental and utility support, healthcare financial assistance, and wrap-around services that help families and individuals move beyond crisis toward lasting stability.




